- While applying to medical school
- After acceptance to medical school, prior to matriculation

Students may enter the one-year intensive MPH program prior to medical school, or after the first, second, or third years. Most students enter either before medical school or after years two or three of medical school. Up to nine (9) transfer credits taken in medical school can be applied to the 45 credit MPH program, depending on community health electives taken.

MPH Tuition Policy:

- Full MPH tuition
- Small fellowships are available such as the Albert Schweitzer Fellowship
- Federal medical school financial aid can be automatically suspended for one year while student obtains financial aid for the MPH program if needed, with no impact on their medical school financial aid.
