Goals of the National CTSA Research Education and Training Committee

- Goal 1: Develop an organizational structure that promotes coordination and innovation with the CTSC RE&T group, the other cores (e.g. translational, informatics, etc) and the COC and a national coalition with partners who share the mission of promoting clinical translational research training including ACRT, APOR, AAMC, subspecialty associations, and public-private partnerships.
- Goal 2: Promote team based, collaborative, interdisciplinary training and research that promotes the recruitment and retention of a diverse faculty, transforming the next generation of biomedical faculty.
- Goal 3: Identify outcomes for trainees that promote and extend the quality of care of individuals and populations served.

Goal 4: Share and disseminate best practices in the metrics of effective training and in curriculum development and implementation

Goal 5: Define the trajectories of training that serve as a guide for individualized training pathways for scholars of diverse backgrounds.

Goal 6: Form an alliance with other partners to become an effective advocacy voice for a health policy that promotes research education and the health of the communities we serve.

Goal 7: Define and disseminate best practices in research mentorship and career development.
