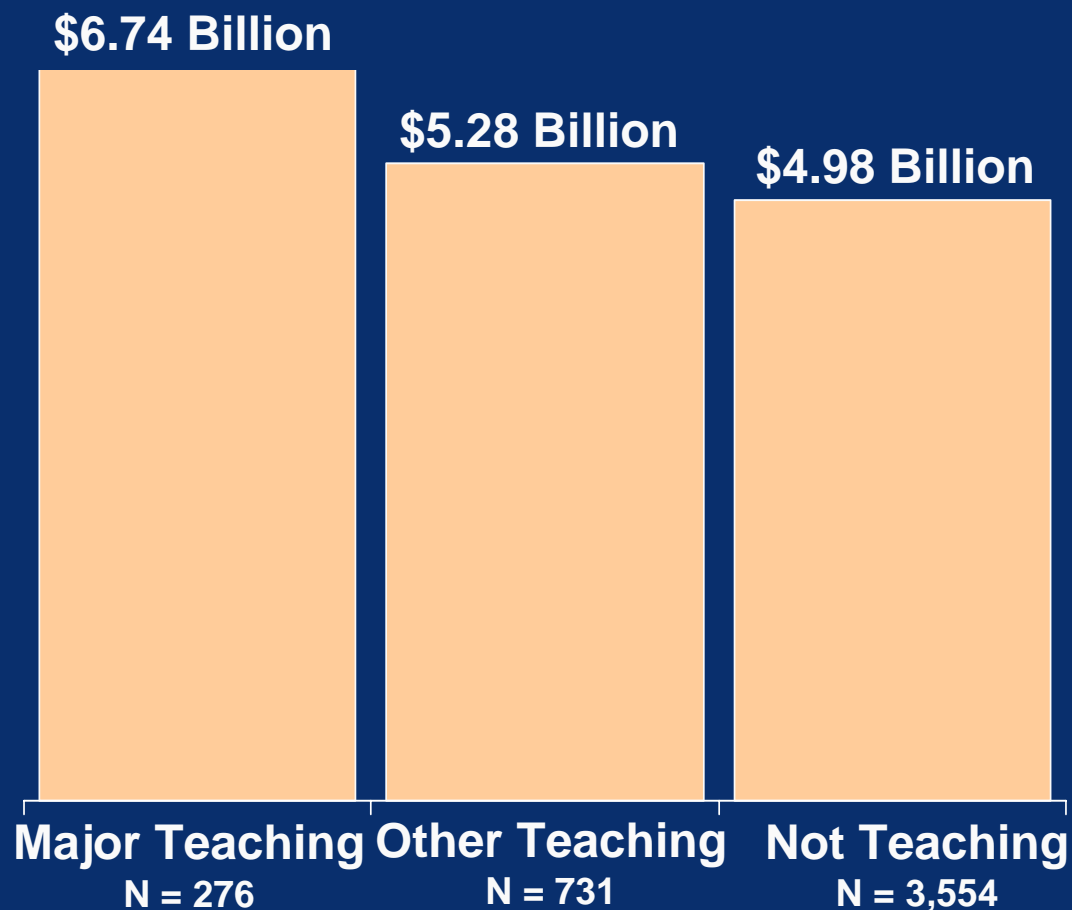


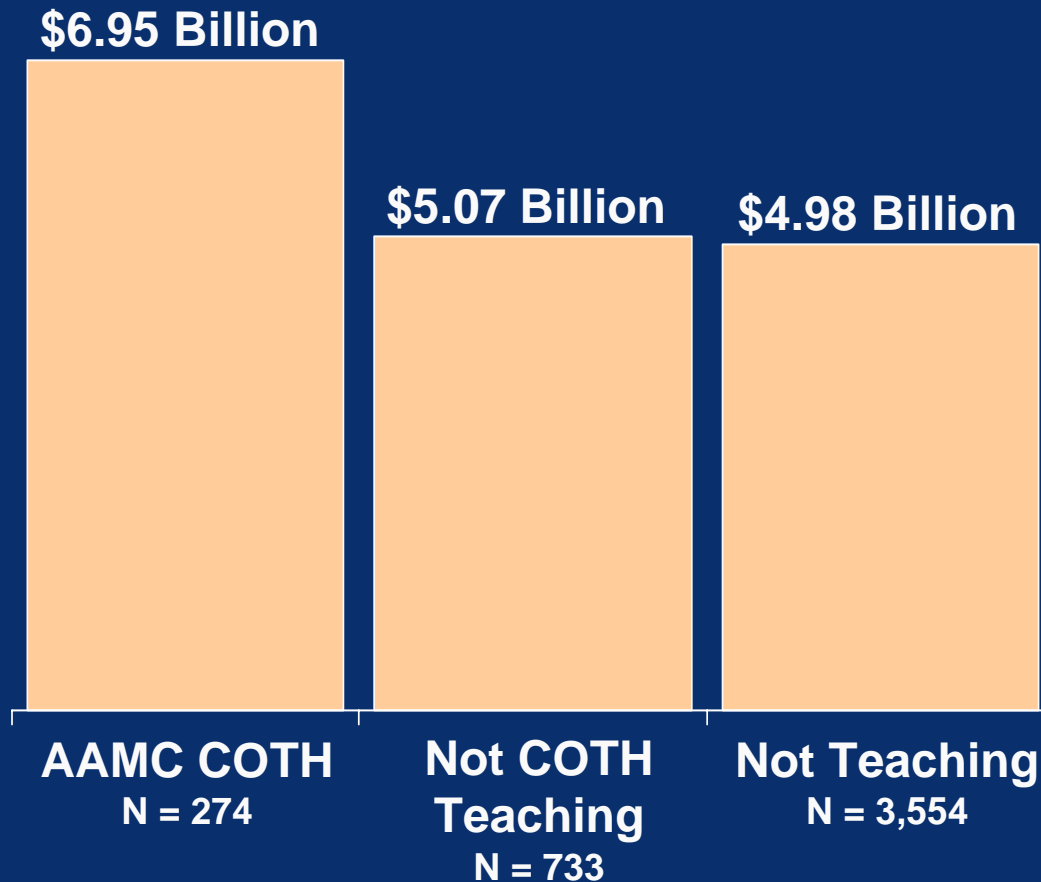
Total Hospital Charity Care Costs, By Hospital Type, 2007

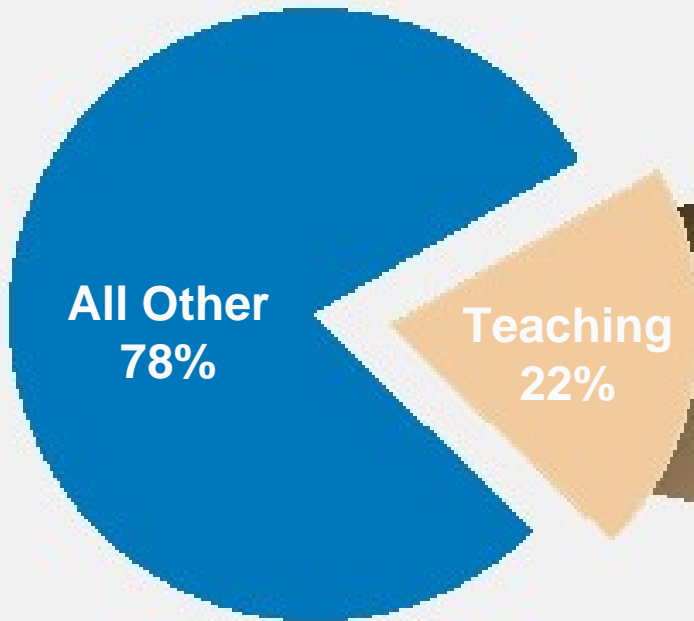

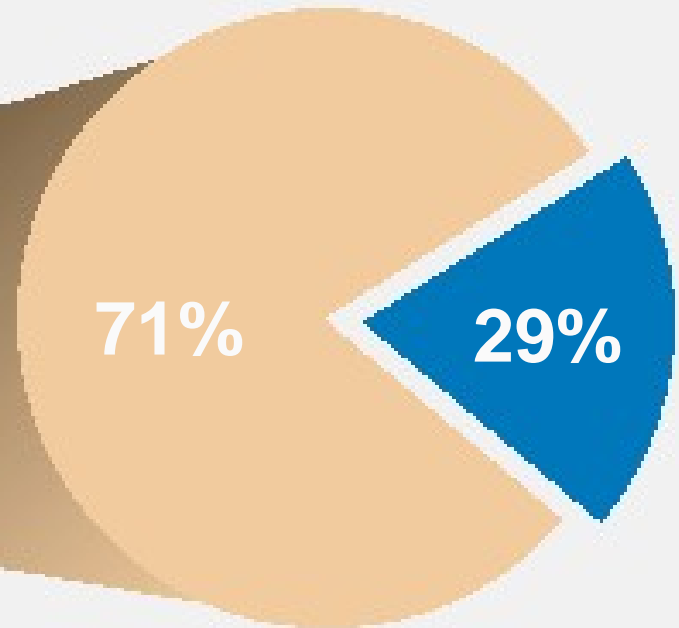

Share of Total Charity Care Costs



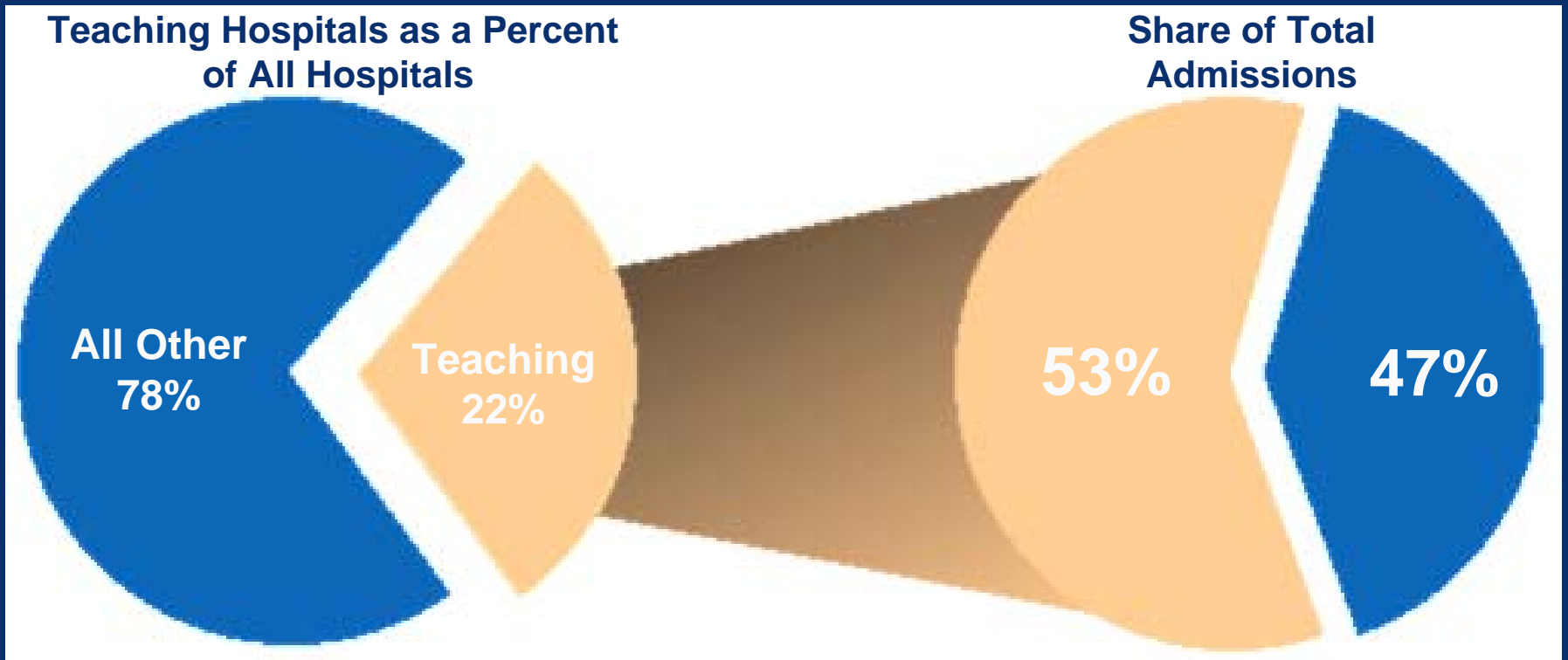

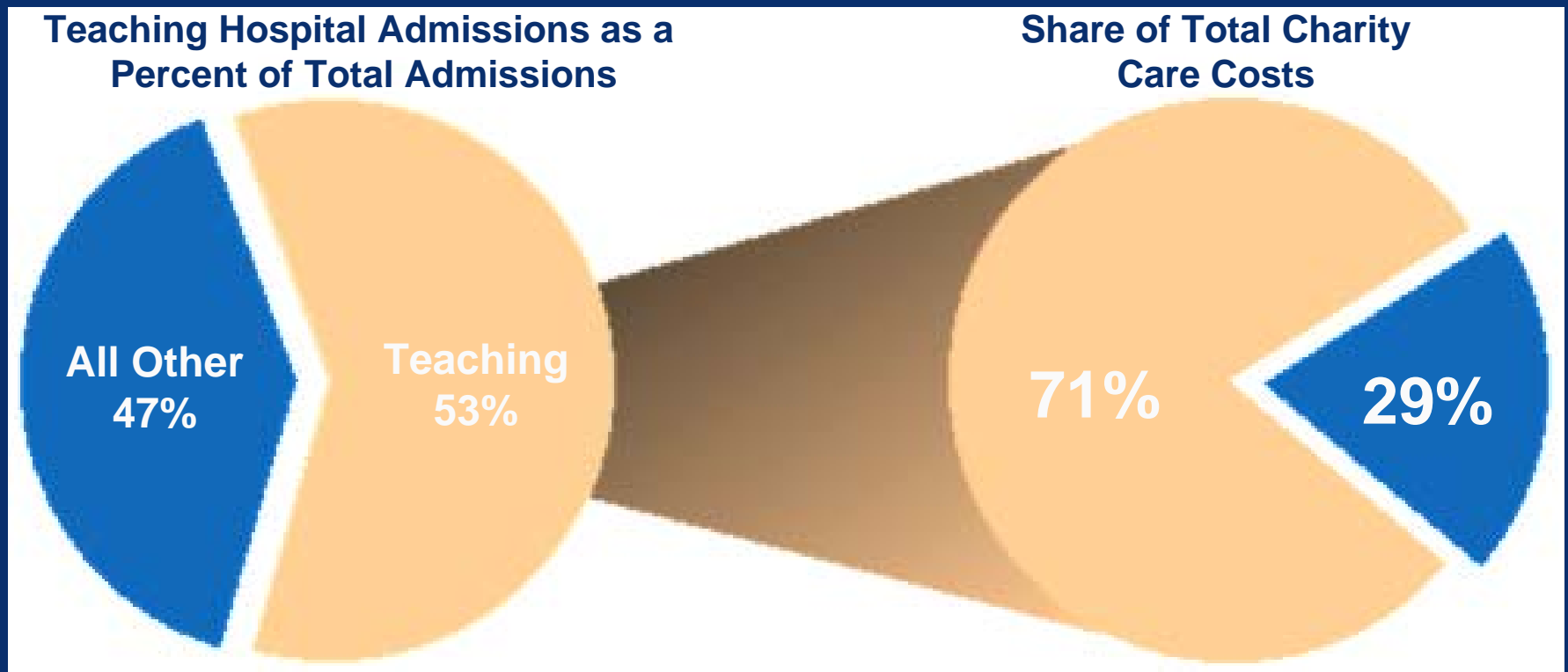

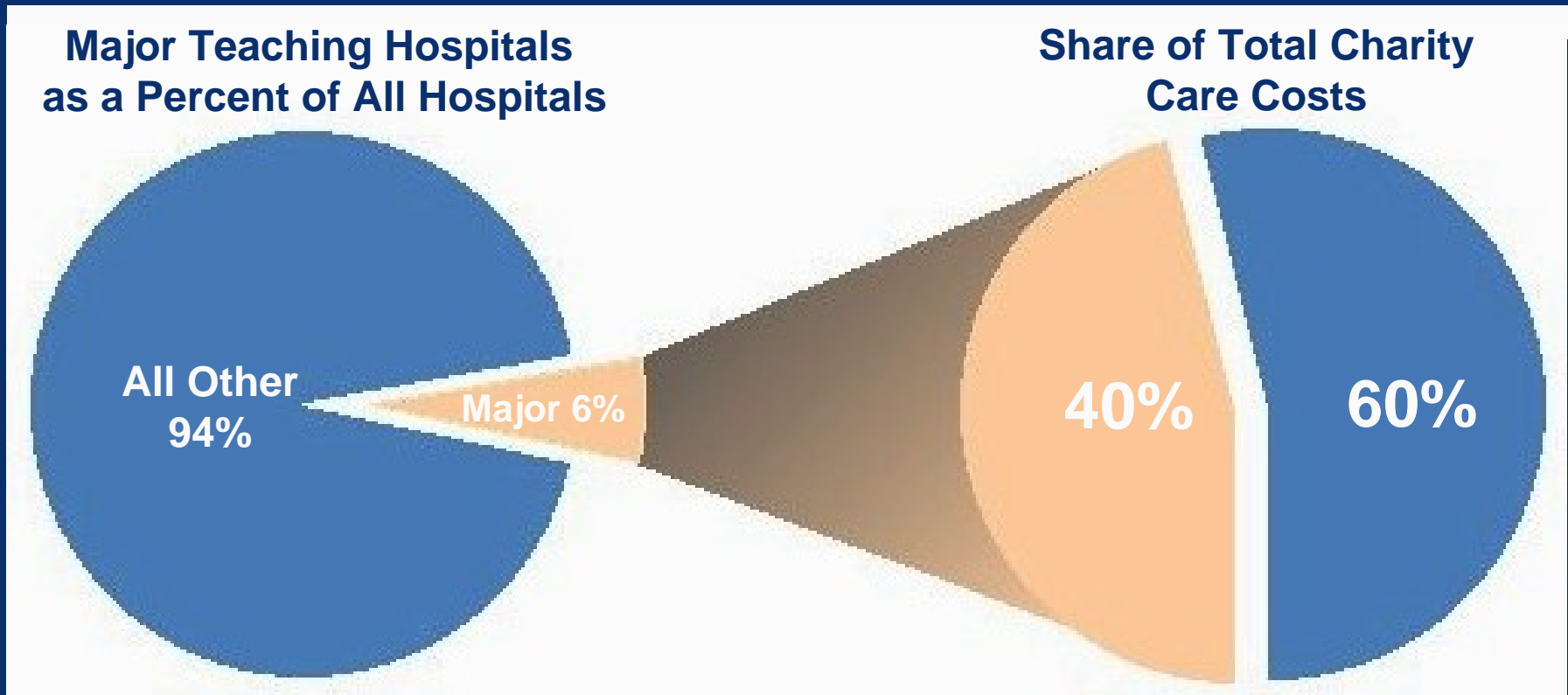

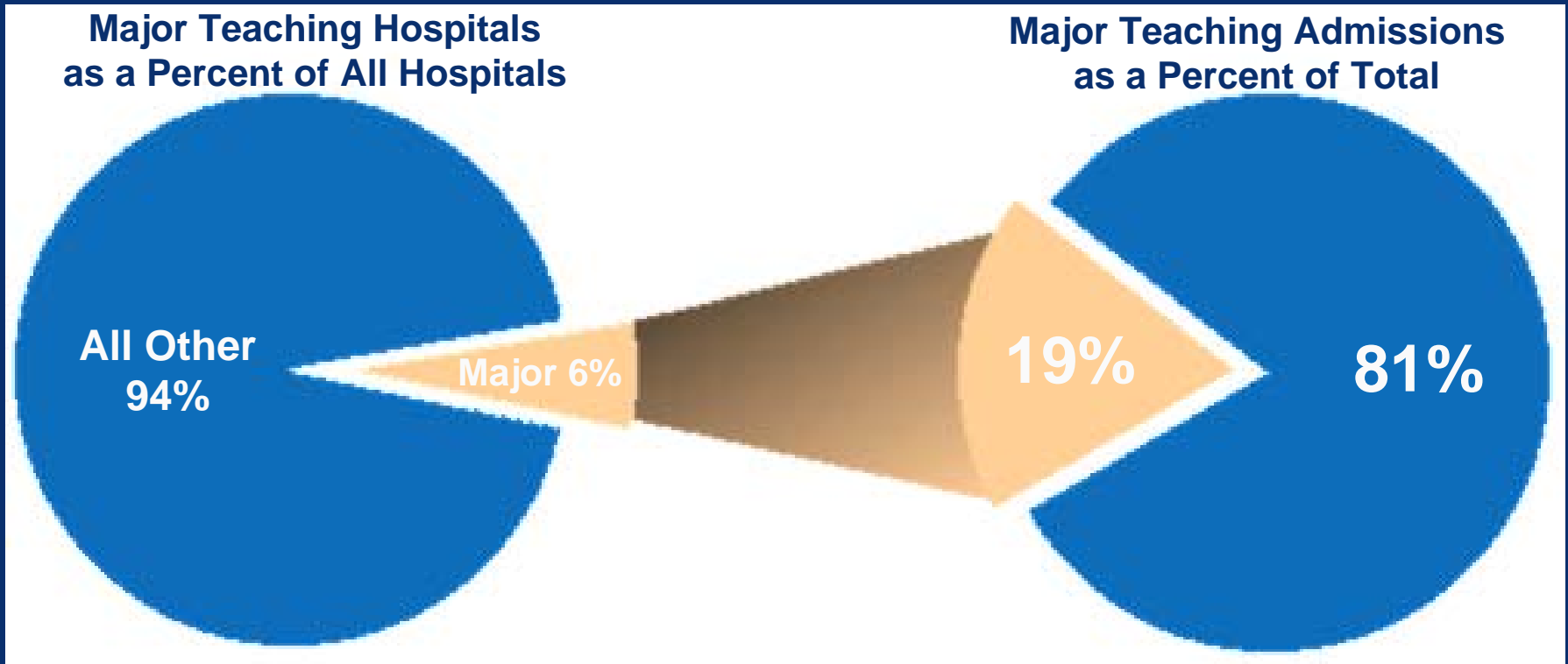

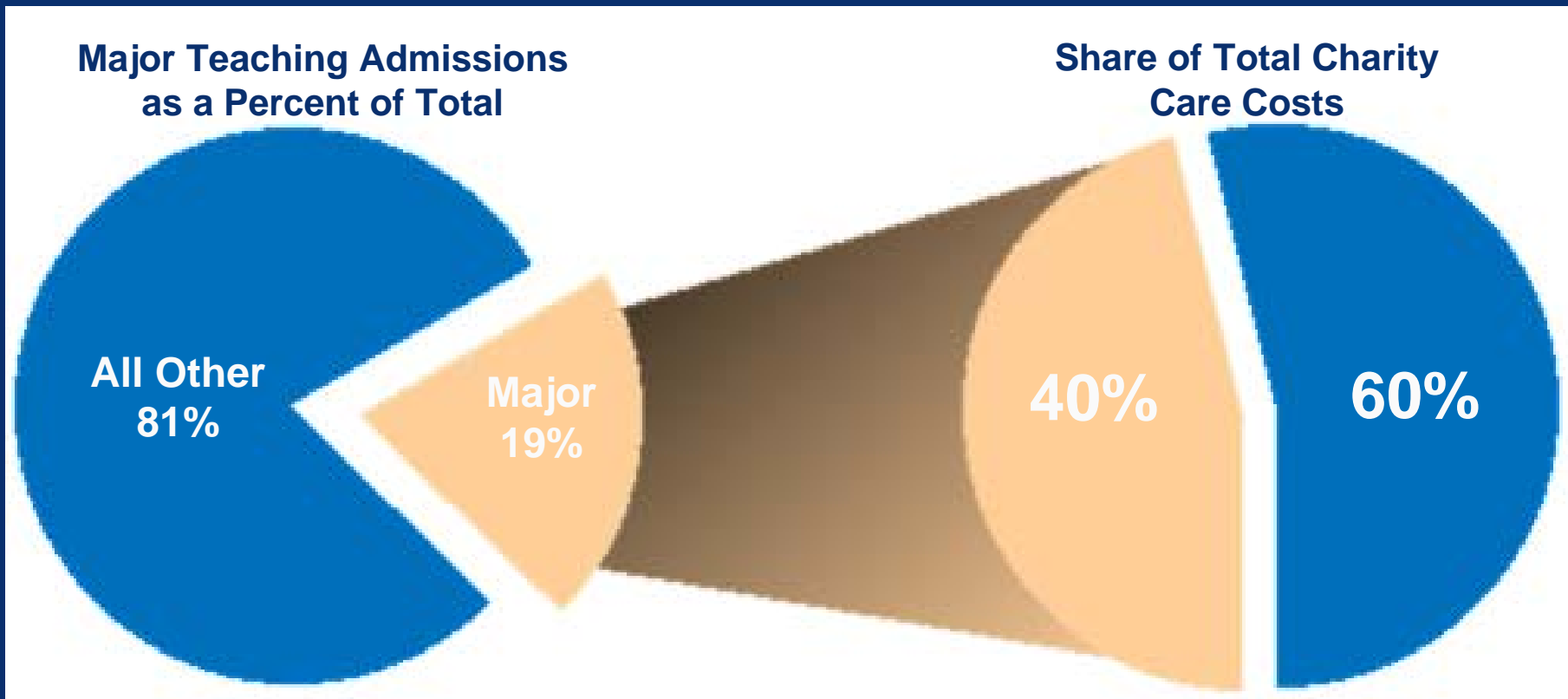

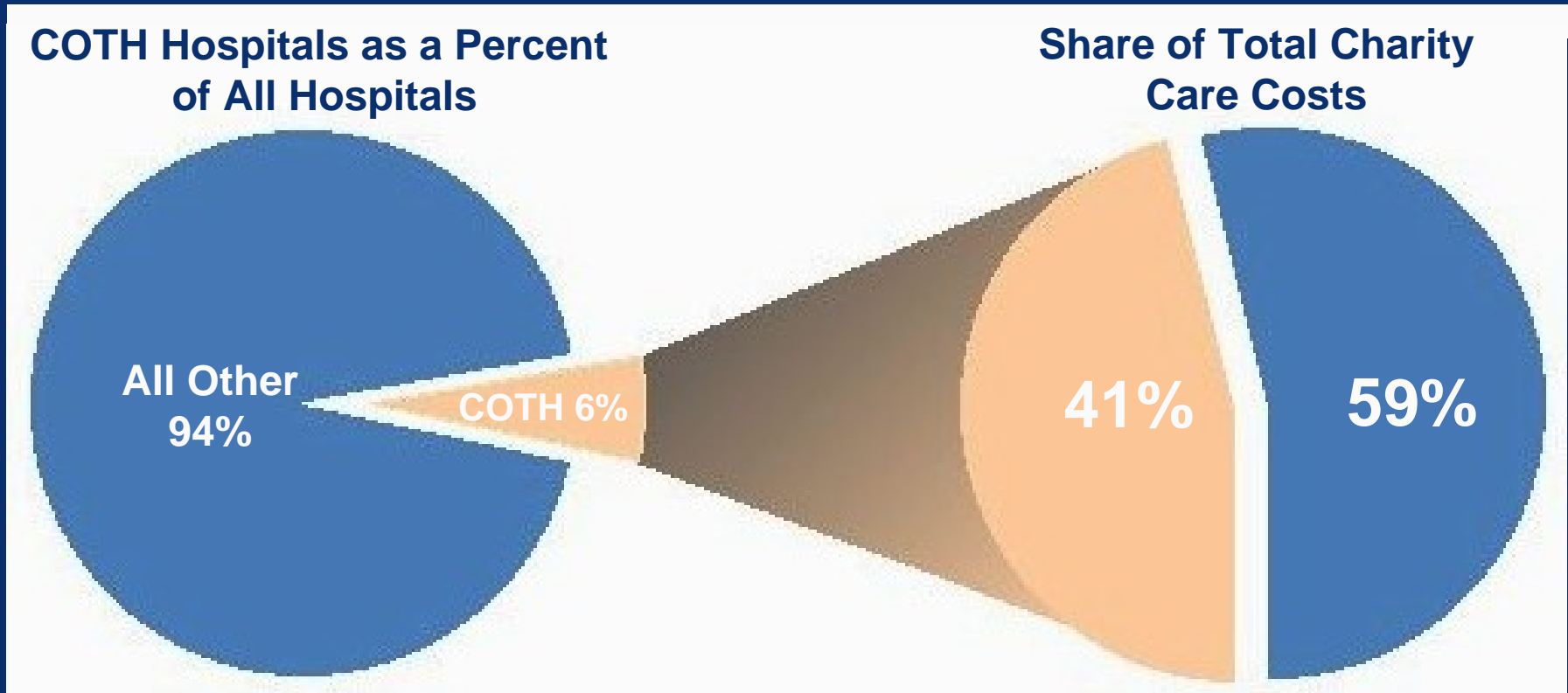

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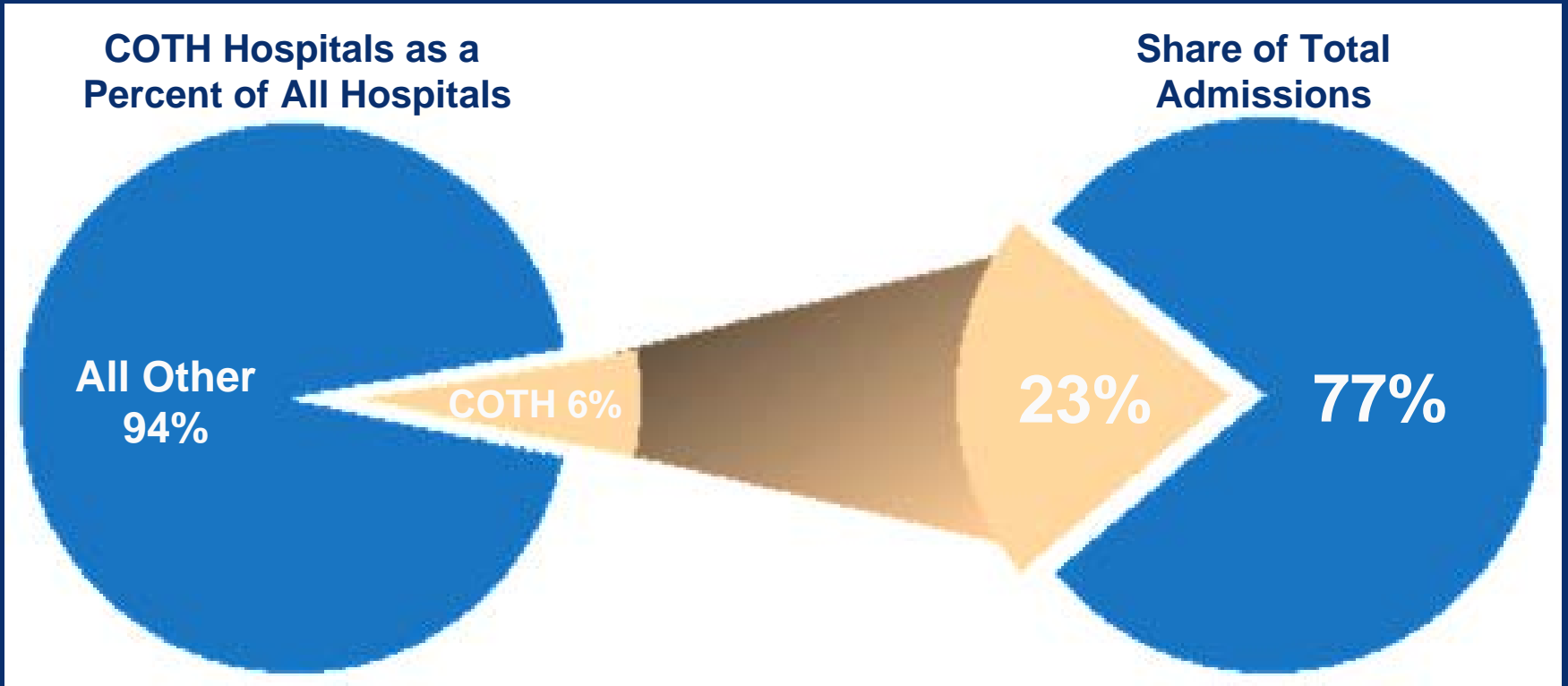

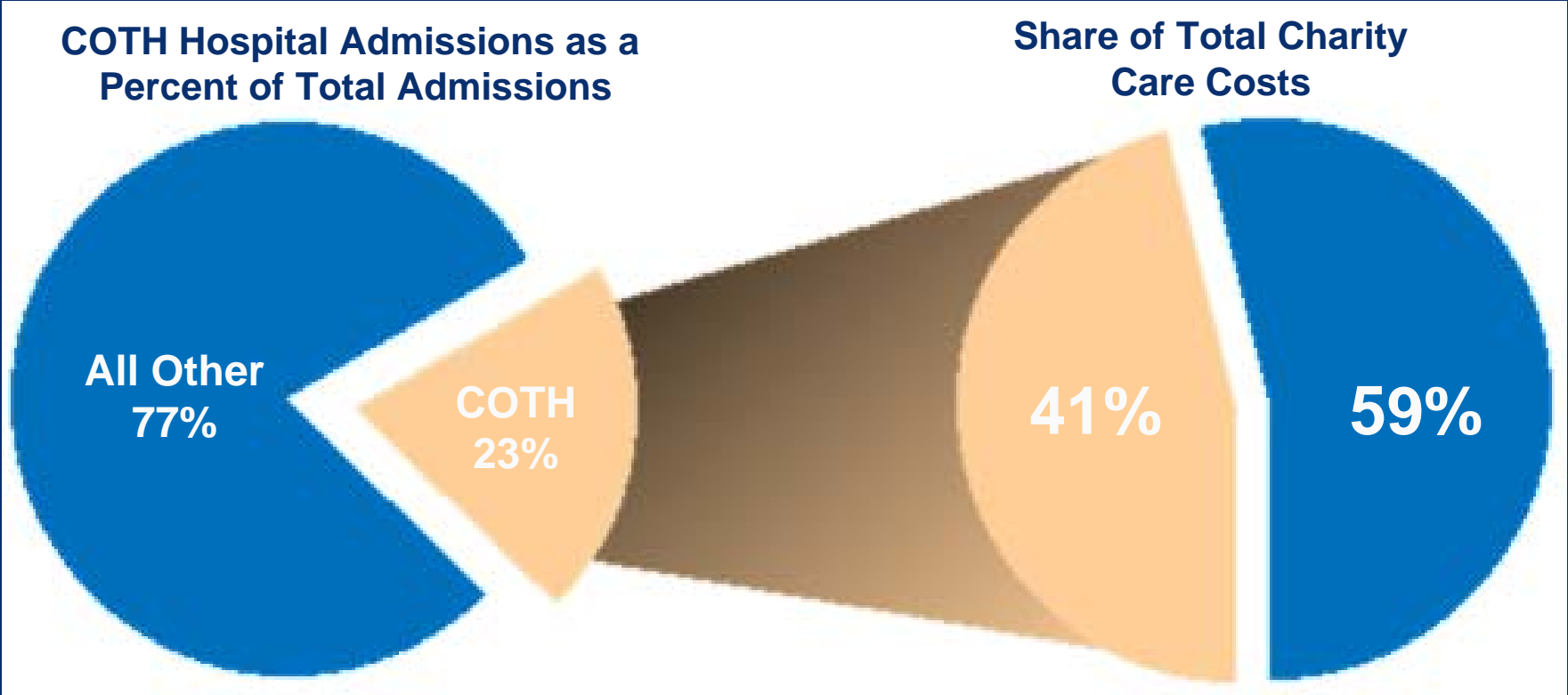

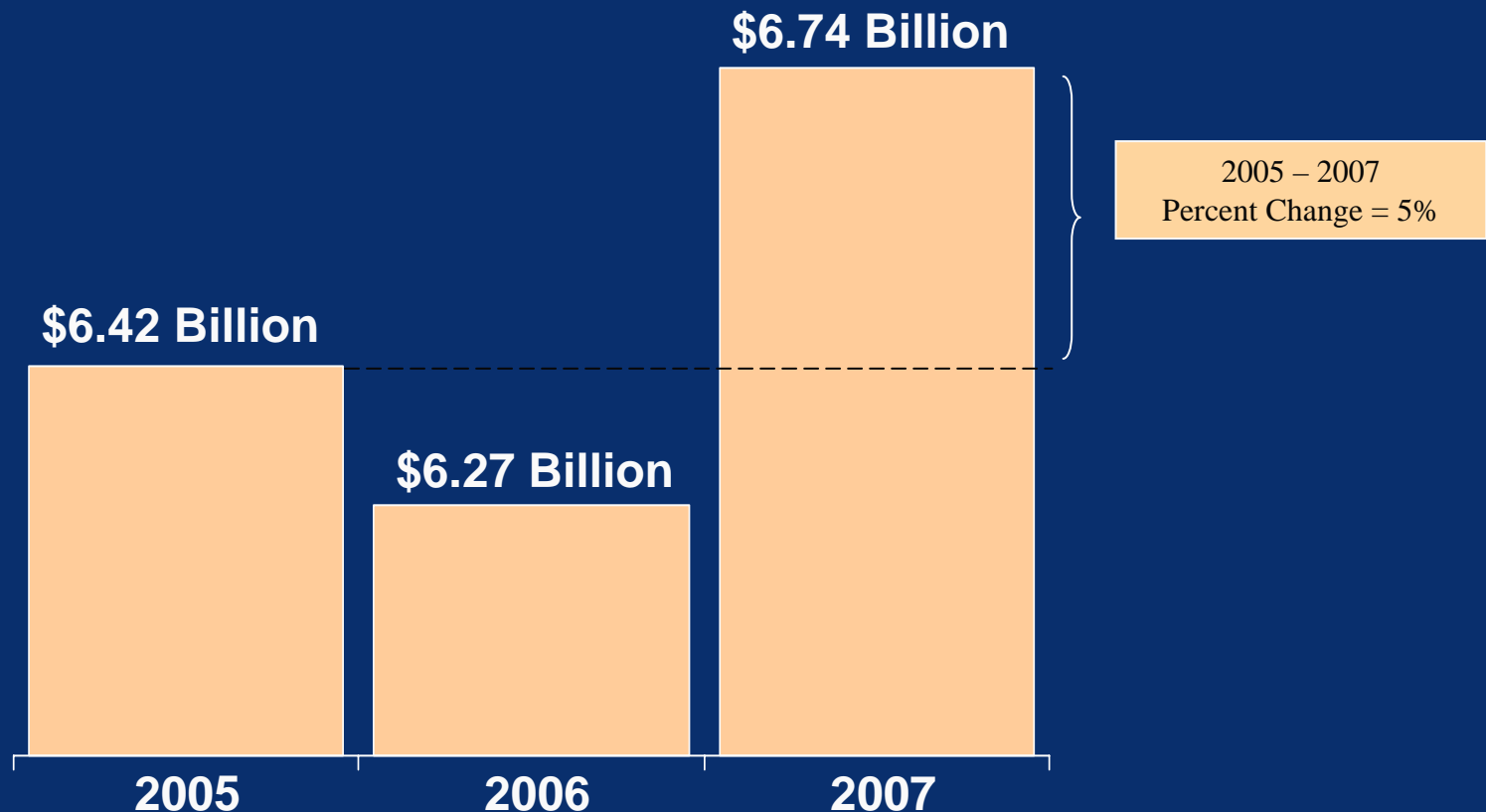

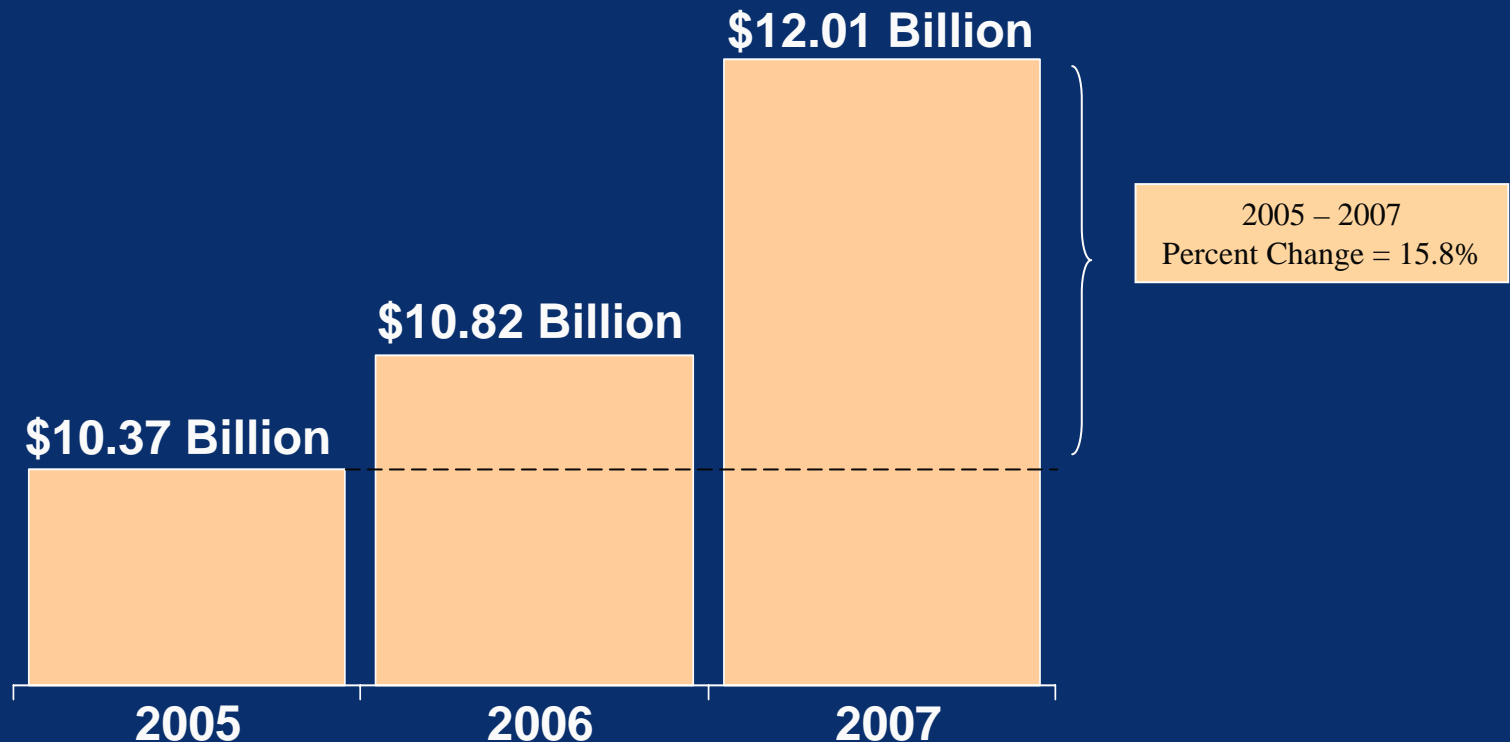

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Teaching Hospitals' Total Charity Care Burden is Increasing...



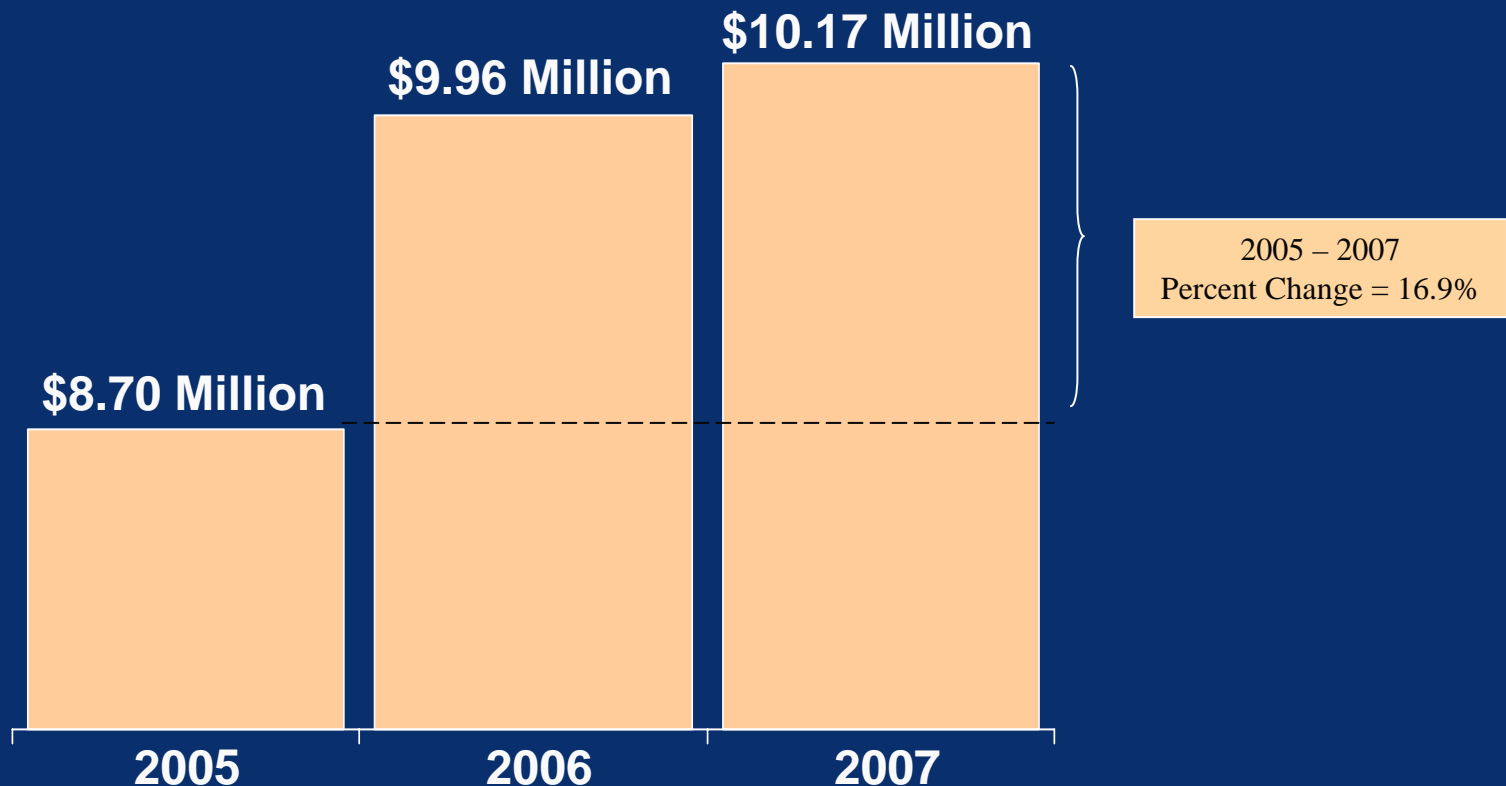
