



### Invitation Email and Login

1. On September 23, you will receive an email from [aamc\\_registration@aamc.org](mailto:aamc_registration@aamc.org) with a one-time activation access code link.
2. If you cannot find the email, please make sure to check your spam/blocked emails.
3. The access link and email is unique to you. Please do not share it with others.



1. Here, you can either redeem access with an existing AAMC account or create a new AAMC account.
2. If you do not recall your account information, use the “Forgot your password?” Or “Forgot your username?” options to retrieve your account information.

1. The access code link is one-time use only and will become invalid after redeemed.

3. Bookmark this page and sign in with your AAMC account username and password.




