

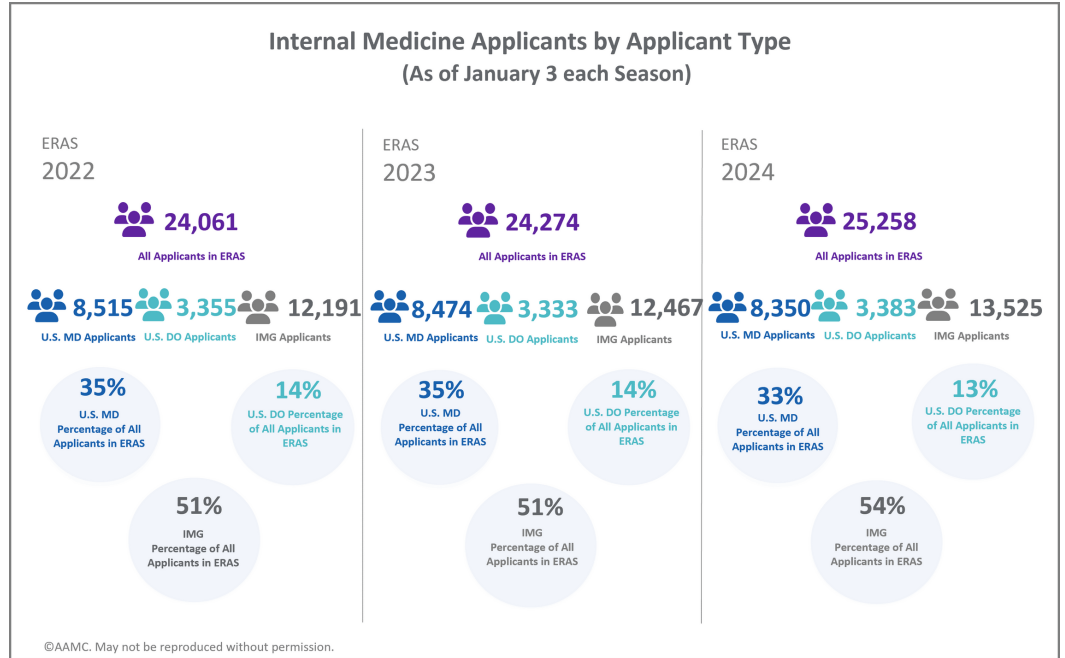

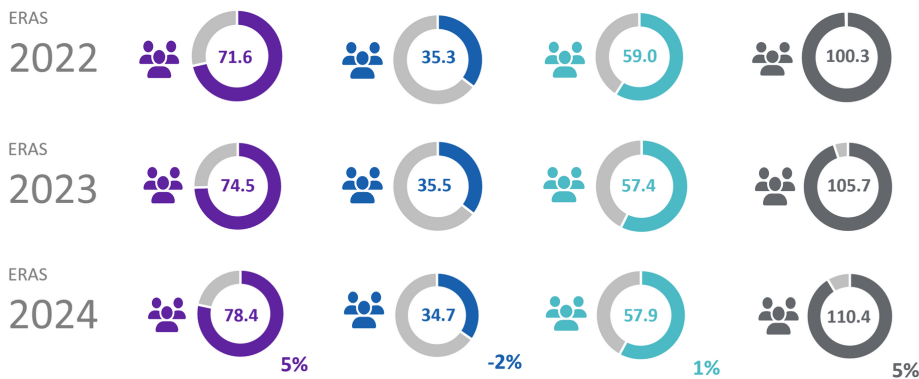

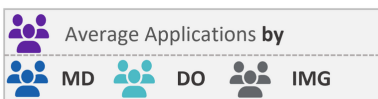


## Average ERAS Applications per Applicant in ERAS 2024 (As of January 3 each Season)

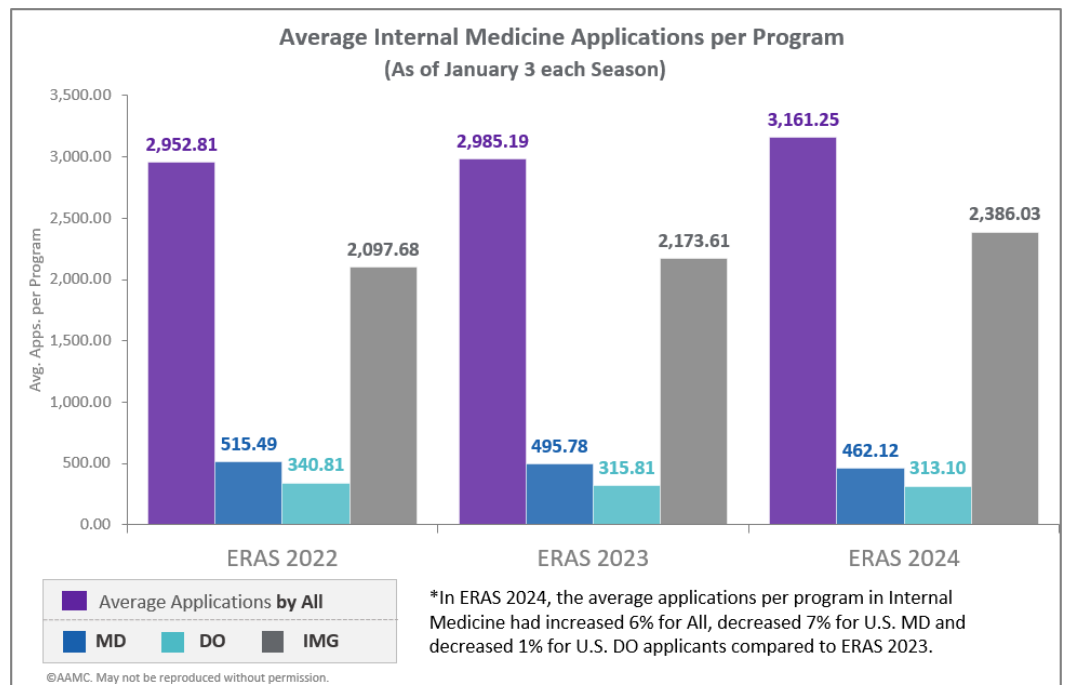

## Average Applications per Program

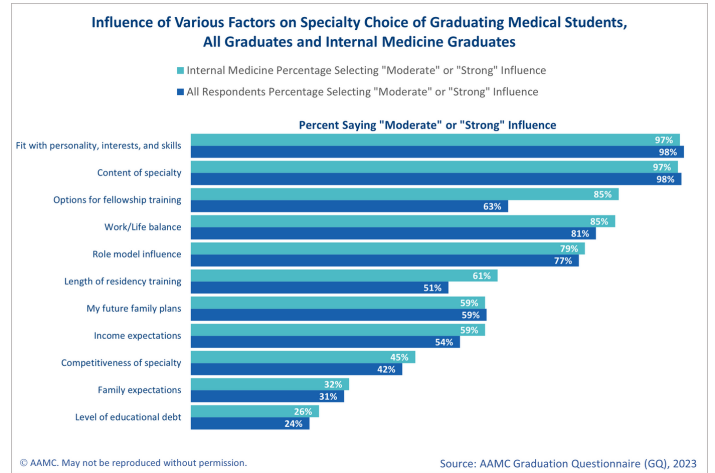
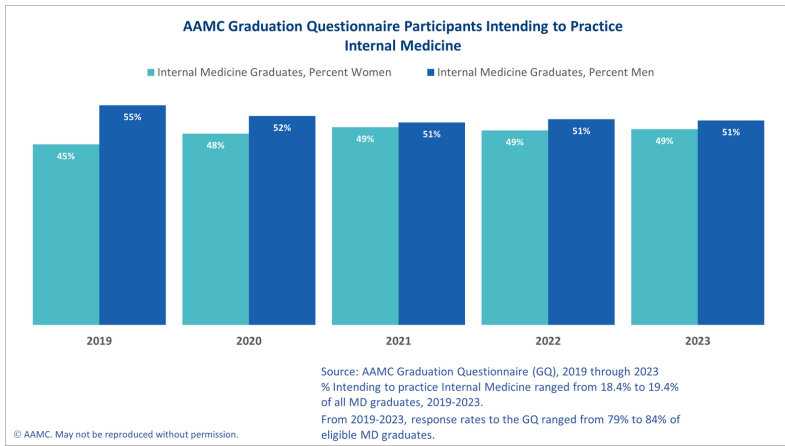

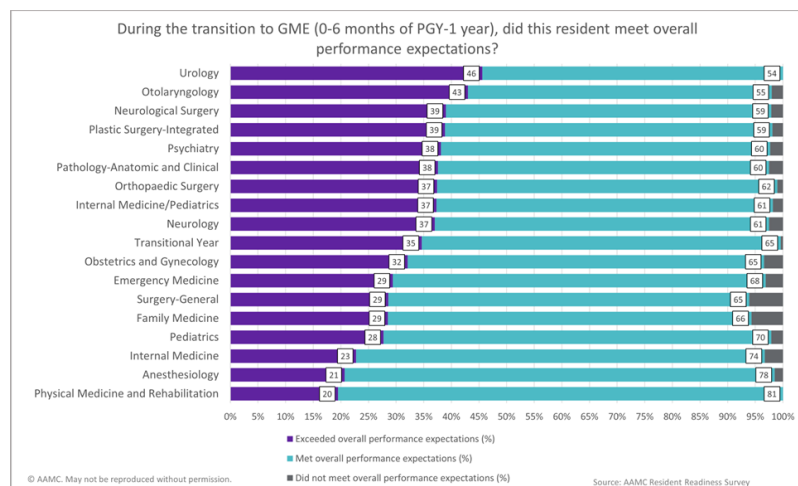
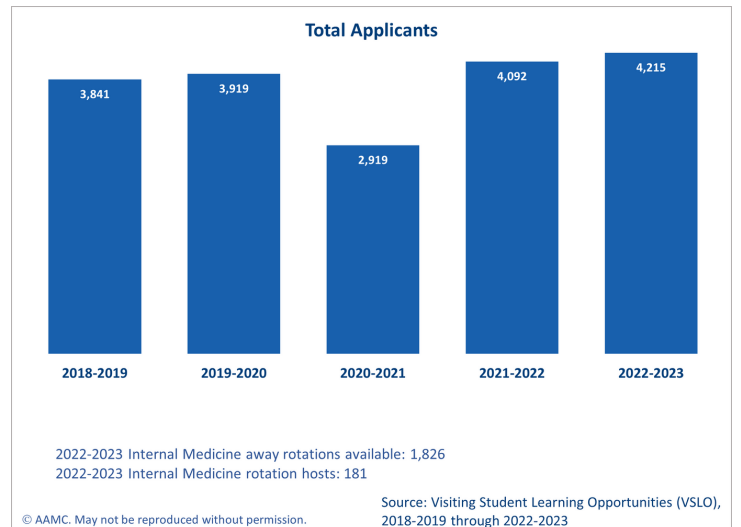
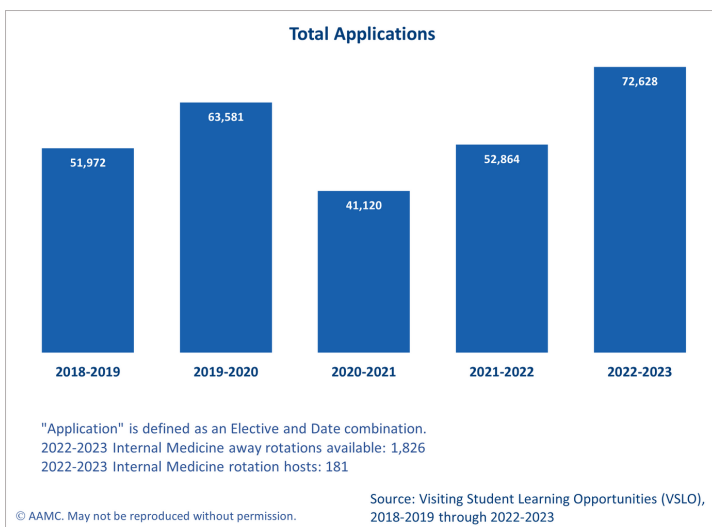
# Graduates Intending to Practice in the Specialty
